

# ACCEPTANCE PROTOCOL

- When you arrive on site you will need to declare the type of material you are bringing to the household hazardous waste depot. The scale attendant will confirm if it is an acceptable product.
- Place the household hazardous waste on the table in front of the depot.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- 1. The site staff have the right to refuse any material deemed unacceptable.
- Materials accepted only from residential households and not commercial products or volumes. The depot accepts retail products only purchased for household use.
- 3. All products must be in their original container.

THERE ARE NO CHARGES TO DROP OFF ANY PRODUCTS AT THE DEPOT.
