REGIONAL DISTRICT OF EAST KOOTENAY

BYLAW NO. 1208

A bylaw to establish a local service within Electoral Area "F" of the Regional District of East Kootenay to provide flood and debris torrent control to the Fairmont Creek area.

WHEREAS a regional district may, by bylaw, establish and operate a local service under the provisions of Part 24 of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS by BC Regulation No. 553-95 dated 15 December 1995, the Lieutenant Governor in Council granted the additional power to the Regional District of East Kootenay to provide flood and debris torrent control as a local service;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of East Kootenay has been requested to and wishes to establish a local service to provide flood and debris torrent control to the Fairmont Creek area within Electoral Area F;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 801 of the Municipal Act a petition of the property owners within the Fairmont Creek area for flood and debris torrent control was lodged with the Secretary of the Regional District of East Kootenay to be sufficient on 13 March 1995;

AND WHEREAS the Director of Electoral Area "F" has consented in writing to adoption of this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Regional District of East Kootenay, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:



This Bylaw may be cited as "Regional District of East Kootenay – Fairmont Flood and Landslide Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1208, 1996".


The Regional Board hereby establishes a local service to provide flood and debris torrent control within a portion of Electoral Area "F".



The boundaries of the service area are outlined on Schedule A attached to and forming part of this bylaw, and the service area is known as the Fairmont Flood and Landslide Service Area.

4. The participant in the local service established under Section 2 of this Bylaw is a portion of Electoral Area "F".





The annual costs for providing the service under Section 2 of this bylaw shall be recovered by requisition of money to be collected by a property value tax or revenues

received by way of grant or other means authorized under the Local Government Act.

The maximum amount of money that may be requisitioned annually for the service provided under Section 2 of this Bylaw shall be \$0.20 per \$1,000 of the net taxable value
